## SEASONAL PROGRAMS FOR 2016-2017

### **OCTOBER: A CHILL IN THE AIR**

soprano soloist, and baroque orchestra of strings, winds and continuo  
Autumn and Winter from Vivaldi's *The Four Seasons*, *Le Ballet des 4 Saisons* by Colasse and Lully,  
and Handel's chilling cantata *Agrippina condotta a morire*

### **DECEMBER: A RUSTIC NOEL**

chamber ensemble of hurdy gurdy, flutes, violins and continuo  
Seasonal chamber music featuring hurdy gurdy, including Chédeville's *L'Hiver* and Naudot's *Divertissement Champêtre*,  
plus Corelli's Christmas Concerto, Bach's Trio Sonata in G, and the modern premiere of a quartet by Janitsch

### **MARCH: THE GLORY OF SPRING**

solo singers, choir, and full baroque orchestra of trumpets, winds, strings, and continuo  
Spring from Vivaldi's *The Four Seasons* and Corrette's motet based upon it,  
plus the US premiere of Alessandro Scarlatti's seasonal serenata *La Gloria di Primavera*

### **APRIL: ZIMMERMANN'S COFFEEHOUSE**

chamber ensemble of flutes, strings and continuo  
A program of music by Bach and his own favorite composers  
inspired by the coffee house concerts of the Leipzig Collegium Musicum

### **MAY: CELEBRATIONS OF SUMMERTIME**

baroque orchestra of strings, winds and continuo  
Summer from Vivaldi's *The Four Seasons*, the modern premiere of Montéclair's ballet *Les Fêtes de l'été*,  
and a selection of Tempesta di Mare's greatest orchestral discoveries from the past 15 years

## ALSO AVAILABLE 2016-2018

### **BACH TRIO SONATAS**

the six sonatas for organ (BWV 525–530) re-imagined for chamber ensemble  
6 musicians: recorder/flute, two violins/viola, lute, cello, harpsichord  
Tempesta's signature treatment of Bach's miniature masterpieces, released as a CD on Chandos in 2014.

### **A TALE OF TWO ITALIAN CITIES**

chamber music from Venice and Naples  
6 musicians: recorder, two violins lute, cello, harpsichord  
trios, quartets and concerti by Scarlatti, Vivaldi, Castello, Falconieri, Mancini and more

### **HOLIDAY IN PARIS**

Telemann's musical vacation  
5 musicians: flute, violin, lute, cello, harpsichord  
music by Germany's favorite composer and his Parisian hosts Blavet, Forqueray and Guignon
